

CAS CHIEF MOUNTAIN BARRELS FUTURITY AND DERBY ENTRY RULES 2021

1. Futurity is open to horses that are foals of 2016 or younger (5yrs & under).
2. Horse must never have competed in any barrel race (excluding time only or exhibition runs) prior to November 15, 2020
3. Derby is open to any horses that are foaled 2014-2016 (7yrs & under).
4. Horses are only eligible to enter one category, either the futurity or the derby.
5. A photocopy, front and back, of registration papers or a certified Veterinarian's Affidavit verifying age of unregistered horse must accompany nomination form.
6. Nomination payments are due July 15, 2021 and August 15, 2021. Payments may be made by mailing two post-dated cheques or one cheque in the full amount. Make cheques payable to the Cardston Ag Society. E-transfers are accepted and can be sent to cardstonag@gmail.com using the password cardston
7. There will be no refunds for any reason.
8. Any NSF cheque will be subject to a \$50.00 fine.
9. Buyouts or selling of futurity/derby entries will not be allowed.
10. Substitutions of horse entry will be allowed for death, or unsoundness. An affidavit of proof from a certified Veterinarian must accompany the substitution with a fee of \$25.00. Must be the same owner.
11. Rider substitution is allowed if the office is notified prior to the start of the event. There will be no additional fee.
12. There will be no late entries accepted for the futurity or derby after September 15, 2021
13. Dress code – Western attire including long sleeve collared shirt, cowboy boots, cowboy hat or helmet. This is for all the events held during the Chief Mountain Barrels.
14. There will be self penning allowed only in designated areas on the event site. Space is limited. A fine of \$50 will be enforced to anyone self penning outside of designated area. You will be responsible for clean up.
15. All entrants/owners/competitors will be responsible for themselves and their horses. All futurity and Derby horses entered are subject to examination to meet registration identifications or examination for age. Any horse found to be of ineligible age, failing to meet registration description will be disqualified from competition.
16. Inhumane treatment of any horse will not be tolerated and will result in disqualification.
17. All competitors must be ready to compete once their name has been announced or they forfeit there run. A designated time limit will be announced prior to the start of the event.
18. There will be 2 go rounds and a short go
19. The top 12 will come back for the short go determined by the fastest 2 times combined.

20. Completion of entry form or payment of entry fee will indicate acceptance of all rules and regulations governing this event.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein contained it is understood that each contestant/owner and all associated to waives all claims against the CAS Chief Mountain Barrels Futurity, Derby, and Open barrel racing, organizing body, workers, etc. for any injury, or loss of damages which may result in any way from the operations of activities of the Chief Mountain Futurity, Derby and Open Barrel race.

Futurity and Derby Format

25% to 1st go, 25% to second go, 10% to short go and 40% to the average

30 or less entries pays 4 monies in each go 2 in the short and 4 in the average

31-60 entries pays 6 monies in each go 4 in the short go and 6 in the average

61-99 entries will pay 8 monies in the go rounds, 6 in the short and 8 in the average

100 plus entries will pay 10 monies in the go rounds 8 in the short go and 10 in the average
